

Rock Hill Area Shag Club Wall of Fame Guidelines

The purpose of the Wall of Fame Award is to recognize Rock Hill Area Shag Club members who have made outstanding contributions within Rock Hill Area Shag Club. Accordingly, nominations for the award will be considered when significant efforts and contributions that have been made within our shag club are clearly listed and documented.

The primary focus is on outstanding contributions of time, talent, and effort to our club. Each club member can nominate one person per year. Nominations may not be made by members of the selection committee.

A maximum of two recipients may be inducted each year. Each person nominated must have been a member for a minimum of 5-years.

A nominee must be nominated by a current member of the club by letter to be considered by the selection committee. The letter of recommendation should include a short bio of the nominee that explains their contribution to the Rock Hill Area Shag Club and their personal information and contact information. Nominee names are listed once on the ballot regardless of the number of recommendations received. The nominee may be living or deceased.

The person making the nomination shall LIST the reasons the nominee meets the criteria for this award followed by narrative information to support these reasons. Below are some guidelines to help the member making the nomination. These are guideline and should be used as such.

- a. Years in the shag club (Must have been a member for five-years)
 - b. Offices held (A bulleted list with dates would be helpful.)
 - c. Committees chaired or served on (A bulleted list with dates would be helpful.)
 - d. How the nominee promotes our club.
 - e. How the nominee regularly and effectively participates in club activities; be specific.
 - f. The nominee's contributions as shag instructor, DJ, creator of a major event.
 - g. Other contributions to the shag club or shag community.
 - h. Is the nominee a positive role model for our club and for this award? Be persuasive!
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Nominations must be submitted no later than October 1st. The selection committee will select the recipients and the inductees will be announced at the November meeting. The recipients will be inducted onto the Wall of Fame during the December party.

The selection committee will consist of the inductees from the previous year if willing to serve, as well as previous Wall of Fame members willing to serve, selected from a random drawing. The selection committee must consist of 5 Wall of Fame members. Members of the Wall of Fame make up the selection committee to maintain the integrity of the Wall. Once a person serves on the selection committee, they will be ineligible to serve on the selection committee the following year. This one year restriction does not apply to the committee chairperson.

There will be a Wall of Fame committee chairperson appointed by the club president each year. Again, this chairperson must be a Wall of Fame member. The chairperson will solicit nominations for the wall, fill the selection committee, and oversee the selection process. The chairperson does not have a vote in the selection process.

It is also proposed that this process is used for the selection process in 2015. Since there were five inductees last year, these five will make up the selection committee. If any of the five are not willing or able to serve, previous Wall of Fame members willing to serve will be selected by a random drawing.

A chairperson has been chosen for the 2015 selection committee.
