

# USA GRAND NATIONALS DANCE CHAMPIONSHIP

Established in 1995, GNDC is the largest and most diverse Carolina Shag and West Coast Swing Dance Event in the World. It hosts all different styles of dance from shag to swing to cabaret and everything in between. Due to covid, this event has not happened since 2019, which marked it's 25th anniversary.

#### IT IS BACK IN 2023 - MAY 25-29 - IN ATLANTA, GA.

This is such a fun-filled weekend with dancing going on from early in the mornings with floor trials to social dancing with new friends to wee hours of the next morning. Kids will meet and establish new friends from all over the country and even overseas. That is how far dancers come to compete at the GNDC. It takes tons of practice, hard work, and dedication to get to this level. Hats off to all who competed. There are workshops for all different styles of dance taught by the best of the best instructors. Then comes the competitions: Shag Jack & Jill, Pro-Ams, Non- Pro Carolina Classic - and that is all before the Opening Ceremonies on Friday night. Then comes the big dogs – Rising Star, Pro Carolina Classic, and Showcase (which is awesome), then more Social Dancing and a Vinyl Party from 11 pm until ???. Saturday brings Jack & Jills (all levels), an afternnon of shagging and a Junior Pizza Party, Ice Cream Social, more competitions in the higher levels, Masters Carolina Classic, Teams and so on. Saturday night after midnight comes the Theme Party & Costume Contest. It is just amazing all that goes on. Sunday brings more workshops, Masters, Pro-Am Routines, Junior Shag, Cabaret, and Champions Strictly. Then Sunday night it all comes to an end with the Awards Ceremony where everyone dresses up. It is such an amazing event. Thank you to Michael & LeAnn Norris, owners of GNDC, for putting on such a wonderful event that brings all dancers together.

We had (3) of our club juniors to attend this event and compete in several divisions: Lauren Cookman, (daughter of Ruth & Duncan), Landon and Logan Sellers (grandsons of BB & Rick Morrison). This was Landon and Logan's first time at GNDC. They danced in Junior Shag and Pro-Am Strictly. They did such a terrific job and took home tons of memories. Lauren has competed at GNDC several times. 

# SHAGGIN' IN ROCK HILL


