

We just finished our last Adult Beginner I Shag Class for the year, with (26) in attendance. I must say this was one of the best classes yet. Everyone learned the start, basic, female turn, trail, male turn, and belly roll. This is a progressive class, learning a new step each week. Everyone has the opportunity to come early each week for extra help if it is needed. This helps to keep the class moving so no one gets left behind.

This is the 4th Adult Class we have taught this year, along with (3) Junior Classes. We have had several members from our classes join our club this year. Some of them have already jumped in to help in some areas. This is fantastic. We look to pick up more members with more classes. Please make them all feel welcome. Be sure to ask them to dance.

We get some "repeaters" in each class. This lets us know they are serious about continuing to learn and get better. Even my instructors, including myself, take away something new and better with each class. If you want to brush up on some steps and perfect them a little, think about taking our next class. 
