Mardi Gras has been lighting up Louisiana since **1699**, when French explorers celebrated near the Mississippi River. By the 1700s, New Orleans was already dancing, masking, and throwing Carnival balls. The first parade-organizing krewe formed in **1856**, and by **1872**, the famous colors — purple, green, and gold — made their debut. Louisiana made it official in **1875**, declaring Mardi Gras a state holiday. A whole lot of history behind one fabulous party!
