2<sup>nd</sup> Place: Will Benoit & Abigail Hodges

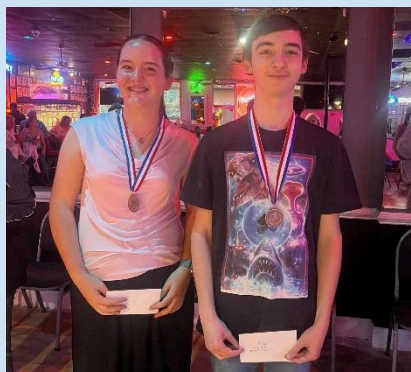
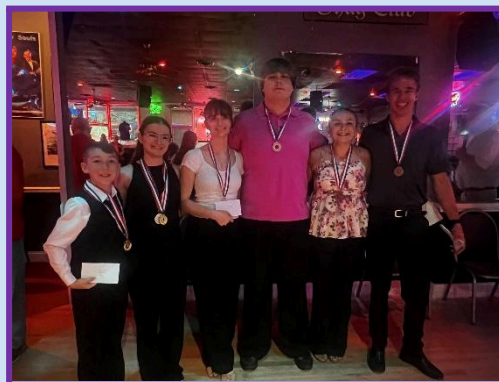
3<sup>rd</sup> Place: Carson Fogel & Claire Fogel

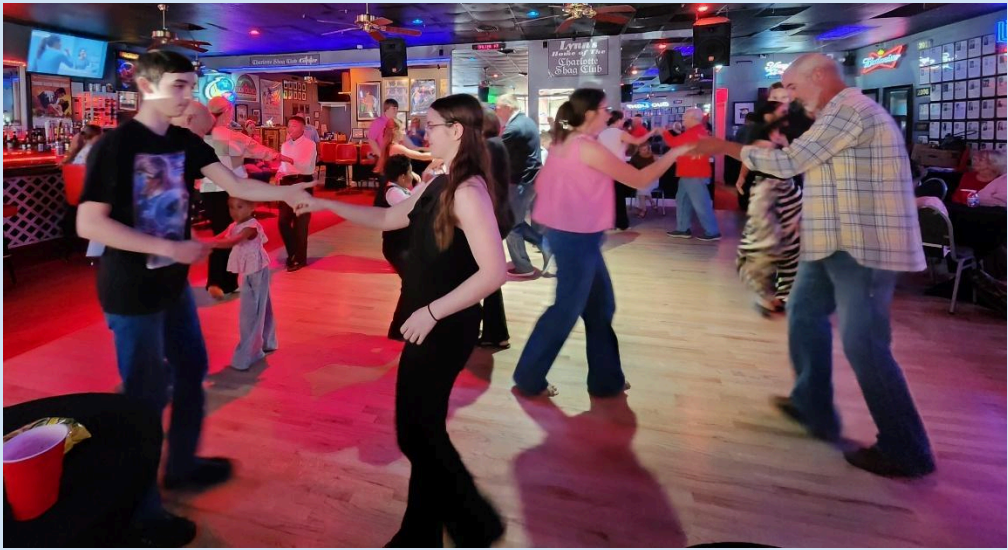

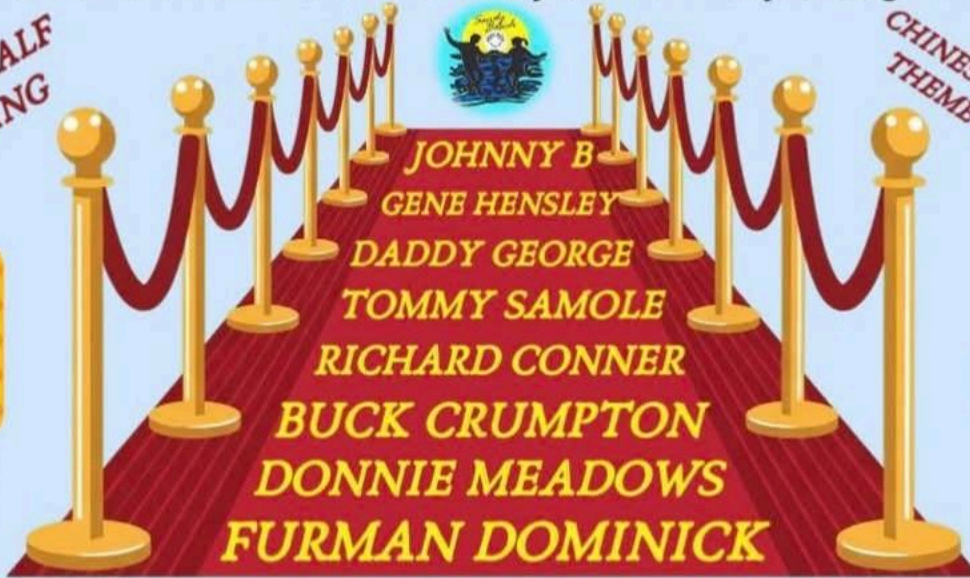
